“Hope is grief’s best music.” ~Author Unknown

As I write this article, it is yet another gray day on the Peninsula. Yet many of us hold hope that we will be blessed with an actual summer in the remaining weeks before fall. It occurs to me that many approach life with the proverbial “glass is half full” philosophy, while others are clearly convinced the glass remains half empty. No doubt our personal life experiences are one of the biggest factors in how we look at the glass and therefore life.

At VHOCC, I sense hope in the eyes and voices of patients and their families when they come into the office, or call to see how we can help them with this part of their journey. I see hope in the actions of the nurses as they leave to check on a patient or to talk with a family member. The volunteers that travel to a patient’s home provide hope and respite for the caregiver. The office volunteers are hopeful as they come in to be trained, not only on office procedures, but to understand the wide range of services available and how to utilize these resources to do the best job possible. The facilities and equipment guys share in this hope when they see that their job entails more than just dropping off or picking up the equipment, but that their presence comforts families. They perform the physical duties that cannot be managed by distraught family members. The computer crew participates in our message of hope as they stretch themselves to learn what our needs are and how they can be met.

The look of hope on the faces of those attending their first grief session, and the renewed hope they have after the sessions conclude, help to spread the message that we, as a lifeline, try to provide to the community on a daily basis. We salute the community organizations who sponsor fund raisers which allow us to continue to provide care and services to a family in our community. This is what our work at VHOCC is all about. It’s an amazing “full circle” that touches each one of us in some capacity. This circle of hope is a strengthening facet of our community, in that life itself is not worth living without the sense that there is meaning to our existence. Each person in the circle is

a link, bringing strength to someone to go on “one more day” or “one more hour.”

One part of the “whole” is Paula Richter, another of our nurses. She grew up in Seattle and graduated from Peninsula College of Nursing in 1980. Married with two grown children, Paula loves anything that has to do with the beach, camping, wine tasting, remodeling, taking walks and being with family and friends. She said she can’t remember a time when she thought about doing anything else with her life, except being a nurse. At the ripe age of 16, she applied for a nurse’s aide job in Seattle, and has been working in the health care field in some capacity for just under 40 years! Paula’s career has included many different settings along the way, from an operating room in Alaska to the Pediatric Clinic in Port Angeles. She has been with VHOCC since 2008 and says of her career prior to hospice, “they [previous assignments] have paled in comparison to the way I feel about being a hospice nurse. For the first time, I feel like I am exactly where I belong. I love the people, the work, and the challenges; and while I cannot say just how long I will be able to do this type of work, it is a privilege to be a part of this organization.” It is a privilege to have someone as committed as Paula on the staff here at VHOCC. We also feel that you are exactly where you belong.

Esprit Conference Raises Money For Hospice

The Esprit Transgender Clubs from throughout the Pacific Northwest held their annual Esprit Conference at the Red Lion Inn in Port Angeles during the week of May 15 through May 22. This was the 22nd consecutive year that this event has been held in Port Angeles and each year 100% of their proceeds have been presented to Volunteer Hospice Of Clallam County. Suzanne Adams served as chairperson for this year's organizing committee consisting of 23 members from Esprit Transgender Club's in Seattle, Portland and Vancouver, Canada. Adams stated that when Port Angeles first allowed Esprit to hold their transgender conference in Port Angeles, the Esprit group wanted to do something nice for the city to show their appreciation. "VHOCC was specifically chosen to be the recipient of Esprit's proceeds each year because they are a non-profit charitable organization that provides an invaluable service to so many people in Port Angeles and its surrounding areas," Adams said. This year's event attracted 160 participants from throughout the state, country and internationally. The Esprit Conference agenda included a silent auction, town show, dance and raffles. The items auctioned and raffled were donated by various Port Angeles merchants, conference vendors and attending Esprit Transgender members. The total proceeds from this year's event exceeded that of any previous year and a check for nearly \$4000 was presented to VHOCC. Sue Hynes, Executive Director at VHOCC, accepted the check on behalf of hospice and expressed her heartfelt appreciation for the efforts made by the Esprit Transgender members, the contributing Port Angeles merchants and conference vendors for making this welcomed donation possible.
